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Description of Classes and Rules

NO DRONES OR DOGS ALLOWED NO EXCEPTIONS All HORSES MUST BE UNDER CONTROL

Halter Classes: placing will be up to the Judges, reasons for placement will be given for informational and educational purposes. No putty, polish or paint on hooves. Horses must be clean and groomed without products. Judges may touch legs.

Leg Evaluations: Judges must be able to handle the horses legs with out being kicked

Obstacle Course: Can Be driven single or as a team the will be a time limit to complete the course. Placings will be judge on points per obstacle, and in the event of a tie, time will be the deciding factor.

Progressive Gentle Start Barefoot Hook Yourself Horse Pull: An Exhibition of beauty and control, not who pulls the most weight. Length of pull will be 27.5 feet. This is a gentle start horse pull that will progress in weight. Can be ran as a single or as a team. There will be a tennis ball on a cone and if you knock off the tennis ball you maybe be disqualified.

All JUDGES DECSIONS ARE FINAL

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RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (herein defined as including but not limited to the arena, chutes, staging area, approaches thereto and all walkways, concessions and other areas appurtenant to any area where any activity related to the event shall take place) or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or for any purpose participate in any way in the event. THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs and next of kin, acknowledge agrees and represents that he has or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted areas and all portions thereof which he enters and with which he comes in contact and he does gather warrant that his entry upon such restricted area or areas and his participation, if any in the event constitutes an acknowledgement the he has inspected such restricted area and that he finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of his use and he further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, he is in or about restricted areas and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted areas.

1. HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND CONVENANTS NOT TO SUE the promoter, participants, rodeo association, sanctioning organization or any subdivision thereof, arena operator, arena owner, officials or any persons in any restricted area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and leasees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "releasees" from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin for any and all loss or damage and any claim or demands therefor on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise while in the undersigned is in or upon the restricted arena and/or competing, officiating in observing, working for, or for a purpose participating in the event.
2. HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
3. HEREBY ASSUMS FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISE OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releasees or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purposes participating in the event

THE UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities of the event are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release waiver and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the state in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall notwithstanding continue in full legal force and effect.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.
