Breeder Affidavit

An affidavit is a written statement where a person lists facts that they know to be true. For the ABA, this form is used to document horse breeding.

- The **Breeder Affidavit** form is available on the American Brabant Association website and also in this document.
- The owner, who wants to register a horse, has the responsibility to contact the breeder and to have the breeder complete the **Breeder Affidavit** form.
- The owner will then include the completed **Breeder Affidavit** with their horse's registration application.
- When registering a foal conceived with artificial insemination if no parentage DNA test information is submitted, the **Breeder's Affidavit** and **Semen Collection Affidavit** forms are required.
